## Domaine de la Perrière Les Battereaux

Christophe BAUDRY is the sixth generation of Family BAUDRY to own Domaine de la Perrière which was entrusted to the family by a parchment dating from 1664.

In Cravant les Coteaux, the main village of the CHINON appellation, the vineyard Domaine de la Perrière spreads over 26 hectares today. Not too far from the deep river groundwater these poor and well-drained soils allow the Cabernet Franc to have the most beautiful fruit as possible. Soft wines to drink at an early age or after a few years.

Christophe BAUDRY took over the estate in 1990 with the target to keep tending toward a fruity vibrant wine quality, and to share his passion for the grounds, the vines and the wines of CHINON. Now, with Jean-Martin DUTOUR, his associate since 2003, they continue to go further and want to be the link between the past traditions and modernity, with agronomic practices to preserve the soils and vineyards. The conversion to organic was launched in 2018.

The plot called Les Battereaux is located on the mid-slope on clayey fluvial terraces and planted with the oldest vines of the domaine (50 years old in average).
